GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Nominations / entries and participation in the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International Races (CXHKIR) are subject to the Rules of Racing of the Hong Kong Jockey Club (HKJC).
2. The HKJC reserves the ultimate right without assigning a reason to accept or decline nominations / entries and in particular to reject a nomination / entry at any time whether or not it has been previously accepted.
3. The CXHKIR is promoted by the HKJC in which all rights are vested and reserved, to the exclusion of all others, including:
 - a) the title;
 - b) all rights of sponsorship of and in connection with the race and the title;
 - c) all rights of broadcast and telecast, reproduction and transmission of and associated with the race and the title worldwide by any means whatsoever both by sound and vision for the full period of copyright and/or analogous rights subsisting under the laws of each jurisdiction throughout the world.
4. All Owners, Trainers and Jockeys whilst in Hong Kong must:
 - a) be present at all the official functions as invited by the HKJC;
 - b) make themselves available at all reasonable times (including immediately after the race) for interviews by the press and other representatives of the media when requested by the HKJC;
 - c) not carry advertising or sponsorship material other than as required or approved by the HKJC.
5. The Stewards of the HKJC reserve the right to postpone or to abandon the races at their discretion.

NOMINATIONS

1. Nominations are FREE for all 4 races - closing 5 October.
2. A horse may be nominated in two races, specifying the race of first preference and the race of second preference.
3. Nominations should be lodged as stipulated on the attached nomination form and will be accepted only by fax or post or through an e-form available on: www.hkjc.com/english
4. The HKJC reserves the right to reject nominations at any time at its discretion whether or not they have been previously accepted.

SUPPLEMENTARY ENTRIES FOR OVERSEAS HORSES

1. Supplementary entries can be made/submitted on or before Tuesday, 23 November 2004 for horses which were not previously nominated.
2. A horse may be supplemented into one race only.
3. A supplementary entry fee of 0.4% of total prize money in Hong Kong dollars of the relevant race must be lodged in the account of the HKJC by no later than close of business (HK time) on Tuesday, 23 November 2004.

4. The supplementary entry fee is non-refundable after the selections have been announced.

SECOND NOMINATIONS FOR HK HORSES

1. A second free nomination can be made/submitted on or before Tuesday, 23 November 2004 for HK horses which were not previously nominated.
2. A horse may be nominated in one race only in the second nomination stage.



SELECTIONS

Selections for each of the CXHKIR races will be carried out through the following process:

1. The International Panel of Senior Handicappers and Racing Officials will rank all overseas horses that have been nominated or supplemented for each of the CXHKIR races. The Panel will advise the HKJC on their recommendations for selections and if necessary, reserves, in both national and international rank order, paying particular attention to each horse's past performances over the specific distances of each race.
2. The HKJC, following advice from the Panel, has the sole authority and discretion in determining the line-up of each of the four races, and the HKJC decision shall be final.
3. Each race is limited to 14 starters, with a maximum of 10 starters selected from the international entries.
4. Selection of the Hong Kong entries will be decided at the sole discretion of a Selection Panel comprising of the Executive Director of Racing, Head of Handicapping, and Handicapper (Deputy) of the HKJC. Hong Kong horses would be expected to have performed satisfactorily at Group level.
5. The HKJC has, as a selection priority, the overall quality of the fields for each race. The HKJC reserves the right, and has the sole authority to decide on the number of runners of each race, after careful consideration of any entry's overall standing and potential to perform adequately in its nominated race. Therefore any entry, whether national or international, is not guaranteed selection even if the selections are less than the maximum 14 starters for that particular race.

DECLARATION FEE

1. For overseas owners, a declaration fee of 1% of total prize money, in Hong Kong Dollars, of the relevant race must be paid through your account with the nominated Racing Authorities as recognised by HKJC, or lodged in the account of the HKJC by no later than close of business (HK time) on Wednesday, 8 December 2004, or a bank draft

Owners are required to fax a copy of the telegraphic transfer remittance / requisition slip directly to our International Racing Department (fax: (852) 2966 7000). All incoming payments and transfers must be accompanied by the following details: Name of Race, Name of Horse and Sender's Name.

2. For Hong Kong owners, the same fee of 1% of total prize money of the relevant race is levied and payable through the monthly membership account.
3. A declaration fee will be refunded only in the event a horse is certified not suitable to race by a HKJC veterinary surgeon in one of the CXHKIR, to be run on 12 December 2004.

PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION

1. Prize money will be paid in Hong Kong dollars or in another currency upon request, at the Club's prevailing exchange rate at that time. Owners' earnings are tax free in Hong Kong; visiting Trainers' and Jockeys' earnings are subject to Hong Kong tax (currently 10.67%).
 - a) Trainers' percentage: 9% for 1st - 6th places
 - b) Jockeys' percentage: 9% for the winner, 4.5% for 2nd- 6th places
 - c) Stables' percentage: 10% for 1st - 6th places
 - d) Owners' percentage: 72% for the winner, 76.5% for 2nd - 6th places
2. A premium of 50% of prize money (1st - 6th places) will be added to prize money won by horses trained permanently in Hong Kong at the time of the race.

HK\$1 MILLION BONUS : CXHKIR 2004 - APQEII Cup 2005

The HKJC will award a HK\$1 million (approx. US\$130,000) bonus to the owner (at the time of the second leg - APQEII Cup 2005) of any horse which wins one of the four CXHKIR (CXHK Cup / CXHK Mile / CXHK Vase / CXHK Sprint) on 12 December 2004 and the APQEII Cup (HK\$14,000,000/2000m /10f / turf / 3yo+) to be run on 24 April 2005 at Sha Tin Racecourse.
